## Copyright assignment

From January 2015 onward, all authors of Medical Archives retain copyright. They are required to grant the Journal the right to publish their article in print and electronic versions with a clear understanding that the article was not published or archived elsewhere and it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Authors who publish in Medical Archives should accept the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Authors retain copyright and grant Medical Archives the exclusive license and right of first publication with the work simultaneously licensed under a Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial License (http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc/4.0/), which allows the work to be freely used, distributed, and built upon for non-commercial reasons, as long as proper attribution to the work's authorship and initial publication in Medical Archives is given.
- 2. Authors are permitted to freely distribute the Journal's published version of the work (e.g., post it to any institutional repository, social networking platform, or publish it in any other media), with a correct reference to its initial publication in the Journal.
- 3. All manuscripts submitted to Medical Archives are assumed to be submitted under the Gold Open Access publishing model. The manuscripts pass in-house and external peer review. When a manuscript is accepted for publication the corresponding author is contacted with an invoice for payment of 500 Euro editing and publishing fee. The editing and publishing fees are required for substantive editing, facts and references validations, copy editing, and publishing online and in print by editorial staff of the Journal. No additional fees, other than stated above, are required. The Journals accepts donations from sponsors to create a sum for payment reductions or waivers for authors unable to cover editing and publishing fees (a justification of the inability to pay should be provided). Published papers are posted on the Journal website for free downloads by readers.
